

Case No. 1

A three year old male, inspiratory stridor since birth – interview now with mother and the patient who is now 30 years of age.

Case No. 2

Middle aged female with a long standing history of chronic tonsillitis, ear disease. Physical findings include short stature, hyper reflexibility of hand and leg joints.

Case No. 3

Middle aged woman with a long standing history of a lesion of her hard palate treated with radiation therapy. Biopsies for squamous cell cancer or adenocarcinoma of the palate were all negative.

Case No. 4

Elderly woman – history of squamous cell carcinoma. Comorbidities include enlarged skull bones, otherwise negative history. Patient carcinoma of the tongue was successfully treated with laser excision and radiation therapy.

Case No. 5

Elderly woman with a history of bilateral sensorineural hearing loss, purulent serous drainage from both middle ears. Unsuccessfully treated with ventilation tubes. History of pulmonary lesions.

Case No. 6

Middle aged women with a history of bilateral ventilation tubes in the middle ear. History of cardiac disease, renal disease and history of decreased esophageal motility. Patient will demonstrate skin lesions.
