## Quality and Patient Safety Vertical Integrated Curriculum Course/Clerkship Content

Quality Improvement/Patient Safety education at SSOM is accomplished through the Vertical Integrated Curriculum as part of the Topics in Clinical Medicine Course. Lectures, small group discussions, on-line modules, simulations, experience in a quality project and more in-depth study through elective participation constitute the curriculum.

#### YEAR 1

## **Patient Centered Medicine 1**

- Lecture on basic science of patient safety
- Prior to lecture, Review IHI modules on Patient Safety PS 101, PS 102, PS 103 (Login instruction below)
- View video on patient's perspective of medical error and discuss emotional aspects of medical errors in small group discussion

#### YEAR 2

#### **Patient Centered Medicine 2**

- Lecture on basic science of quality improvement in medicine
- Prior to lecture, Review IHI modules on Quality Improvement QI 101, QI 102, QI 103

### YEAR 3

## Third year orientation

- Lecture on Quality Improvement/Patient Safety tools to apply in the clinical environment, including handoffs, communication, error disclosure, error reduction methods, quality/safety metrics
- Complete IHI module QI 104/105
- LUHS Annual Safety Competency

## All Clerkships

• Attend Department Quality Improvement and Patient Safety Conferences (in some Departments named Morbidity and Mortality Conferences) while on each rotation.

## **Experiential Component**

- Complete a meaningful activity related to Quality or Safety. This can include participating in departmental quality initiatives, attending above mention quality/safety meetings, participation in formalized quality improvement projects, performing chart reviews/audits, etc. Activity Participation will be coordinated by Curriculum Directors.
- Prepare narrative discussing experience, limited to 1 page
