Parking	<p>After your first day, you <u>must</u> have a blue parking placard to identify your car as a non-employee/non-patient. The blue parking placards are in the ED attending office hanging from a clear folder.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ MacNeal's Parking Lot #3, located at 3317 Grove Ave. Berwyn, IL 60402. Parking is free of cost. It is about a 5-minute walk from this lot to the MacNeal Hospital building. ○ MacNeal Off-Site Lot, located at 2900 S. East Ave. at Janura Park. Parking is free of cost. It is about a 20-minute walk from the offsite lot to the MacNeal campus. ○ MacNeal's Parking Lot #2, located Euclid Ave. & 33rd Street. You may utilize this lot only when scheduled: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Weekends, any shift ➤ Weekdays, 2 PM – 10 PM ○ MacNeal's Employee Parking Garage, located at the corner of Euclid Ave and Windsor Ave, with the entrance on Windsor Ave. You'll need your MacNeal ID badge to open the gate. You may utilize this lot only when scheduled: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Weekends, any shift ➤ Weekdays, 2 PM – 10 PM
Reporting Time & Location	Defer to SSOM coordinator for your shift schedule. You'll enter the MacNeal ED department through Entrance A (<i>Emergency Room entrance</i>).
Orientation & Badge	There will an orientation presentation sent to you by Adriana explaining how you'll proceed on your first day. Email Dr. Connolly if you have any questions after reviewing that presentation. Adriana will confirm with you a week in advance that your SSOM ID badge has MacNeal campus access. For any ID access issues please contact her.
Dress Code	Please wear scrubs. Additionally, students must wear clean, professional white lab coats that clearly distinguish them from physicians and other healthcare professionals when with a patient and/or on rotation.

Site/Rotation Description	<p>The Emergency Medicine rotation is 4 weeks long during which students will evaluate and manage patients with emergencies. Students will practice procedural skills and learn to recognize, to resuscitate, and to stabilize seriously ill patients.
