Food/beverage is prohibited in the Unit otherwise • The chief resident has limited snacks and coffee on 14 • The VA has a fully functional cafeteria in building 1 (designated 45 refer to map) Closes after 2pm • The VA has a “Patriot Store” which offers several dry and perishable items. Next to Cafeteria in bldg. 45 on map Closes at 4P • The VA has 2 Fresh Farm vending machines on the first-floor bldg. 1 in the F lobby, the other is near the main entrance to the hospital in bldg. 200. • There is a non-branded Coffee shop in the main lobby bldg. 200 which serves Starbucks coffee/snacks. |
