

## SubI ICU Lottery

There are a limited number of ICU spots (only **18-20 total**).

- 7 MICU:
  - 1 at Gottlieb
  - 4 in Loyola MICU
  - 2 in Hines MICU
- 2 Loyola CCU
- 1-2 Neuro ICU (2 needs Dr. Schneck's approval)
- 2 Loyola Neonatal ICU
- 1 Loyola PICU
- 2 Loyola SICU
- 1-2 CV-ICU (2 acceptable if no away students scheduled)
- 2 Burns ICU

Based on feedback from students in prior years, we have changed the way sites are assigned. The site you are assigned is determined based on your lottery number and the residency that you are applying to. If your selections are not received by the due date (both on my Lumen and the google form), you will be placed in available slots after the lottery is completed.

<b>Residency you are applying for:</b>	<b>The unit you should request</b>
Anesthesia	CV-ICU, Burns ICU, SICU If full, one of MICU sites
Dermatology	Any of the adult ICUs (except neuro ICU)
Emergency Medicine	Any of the adult ICUs (except neuro ICU)
Family Medicine	PICU, Neonatal ICU, or one of MICU sites (MICU, CCU, Gottlieb)
Internal Medicine	One of MICU sites (MICU, CCU, Gottlieb)
Interventional Radiology	SICU or Burns ICU
Neurology	Neuro ICU
Neurosurgery	Neuro ICU or SICU
OB GYN	SICU or one of MICU sites (MICU, CCU, Gottlieb or Resurrection)
Pathology	Any of the adult ICUs (except neuro ICU)
Pediatrics	PICU or Neonatal ICU
PM&R	Neuro ICU, MICU, or SICU
Psychiatry	Neuro ICU, MICU
Radiology/Radiation Oncology	One of MICU sites (MICU, CCU, Gottlieb)
Surgical specialty (General Surgery, Vascular, Plastics, ENT, Orthopedics, Ophthalmology, etc)	SICU or Burns ICU

Take a look at this example:

- Student A has lottery spot #1 and this student fills out the google form stating they are going into orthopedic surgery. Student A chooses Neuro ICU as their first choice, PICU as their second choice and Burns ICU as their 3<sup>rd</sup> choice
- Student B has lottery spot #4 and this student is going into neurology and they list neuro ICU as their first choice
- Student C has lottery spot #7 and this student is going into pediatrics but they did not fill out the google form by the assigned deadline. This student lists PICU as their first choice, neonatal ICU as their second choice and MICU as their third choice
- Student D has lottery spot #10 and this student is going into pediatrics and lists PICU as their first choice.

Student A is assigned Burns ICU (doesn't get 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> pick b/c it does not align with their residency)

Student B is assigned Neuro ICU

Student C is assigned Neonatal ICU (does not get first pick b/c they didn't fill out google form on time so Student D gets PICU ahead of them)

Student D is assigned PICU

Occasionally, we can add extra students to the Neuro ICU but this is only for students going into neurology and needs to be approved by Dr. Schneck. We cannot add any other students to any other site.

We often have external students doing away rotations in the CV-ICU. If there is no external student in the CV-ICU one month, we can allow two subs (students going into anesthesia)

If there is a cohort of students where we have an excess # of students going into a particular residency, there will be students (with lower lottery numbers or those who did not fill out their google form on time) who are not assigned an ICU that aligns with their residency. For example, if there are 10 students going into IM or family medicine, they may end up in a surgical ICU (Burns or SICU).
