Reporting Time & Location	<p>Report to the Medical Education Office at the time the medical student coordinator, Adriana, tells you on the first day of your rotation. Orientation & Badge	<p>You'll meet with Adriana in the Medical Education Office and she will then drop you off with your clinical team. The clinical team typically meets in the EEG room, 3rd floor, of the south building. Your SSOM student ID badge will have MacNeal campus access.</p>
Dress Code	<p>Please wear scrubs and have your school ID badge. Additionally, students must wear clean, professional white lab coats that clearly distinguish them from physicians and other healthcare professionals when with a patient and/or on rotation.</p>
Meals	<p>Hospital cafeteria is open for breakfast and lunch.</p>

Storage/Locker Location	<p>Lockers are available inside the Health Science and Resource Center located on the 1st floor, east building of the hospital—near entrance E. Adriana will assign you a locker during orientation.</p>
Lactation Rooms	<p>We have two lactation rooms on the MacNeal campus. One is located on the 3rd floor, south building of the hospital. The other lactation room is in the basement of the north building. Please be advised we have two basements. There is a basement slightly above from our sub-basement.</p> <p>Both lactation rooms are locked, please reach out to Ms. Rodriguez (rosrodriguez@luhs.org; 708-783-3137) for the key code.</p>
Study/Rest Area	<p>The Health Science and Resource Center located on the 1st floor, east building of the hospital—near entrance E.</p>
Call Rooms	<p>Students do not work overnight. During their dayshift they can meet with their team of residents and/or attending preceptor in the EEG room.</p>

<p>Site/Rotation Description</p>	<p>The Neurology rotation is 2 weeks long. Students will be prepared to identify diseases and situations in which neurological evaluations is appropriate. Furthermore, the clerkship allows students to understand when neurological consultation is appropriate and when emergent neurological intervention is needed.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Become proficient with a basic neurological examination. ➤ Learn and apply the principles of neurological localization to clinical diagnosis. ➤ Know the major categories and cardinal manifestations of neurological diseases. ➤ Be able to recognize common neurological emergencies. ➤ Be familiar with major modes of neurological therapy.
