	Labor and Delivery expectations: Evaluation triage patients, round on laboring patients, attend deliveries and cesarean sections	
	<u>Call:</u> On the first day of the rotation, discuss the call schedule with the senior resident on your team or Dr. Cox. You will do 1-2 overnight shifts where you are off the following day	
	Weekends: You will work 1 12 hour weekend shift	
	Evaluations + Feedback: Evaluations will be completed by your team as recommended by Loyola on the assigned weeks. You can expect to receive feedback from your intern, resident, and attending.
