

Direct Observation

New patient observed interview – ungraded, but required

Students are required to be **observed doing at least 1 new patient interview** during their 6-week rotation, and document this in their *myLUMEN*. This is an ungraded exercise. It is simply meant for you to learn from! Students can be observed by any of the following.

- A visiting PGY4 resident on certain Friday mornings or Tuesday afternoons. You might hear from one of these residents ahead of time to coordinate.
- A faculty member at your site
- A psychiatry resident at your site

Instructions

1. Log into *myLUMEN*, select “Direct Observation,” and follow the prompts
 - Enter the clerkship
 - Enter what was observed – history and/or physical (the MSE is the physical)
 - Select who observed you
2. The selected faculty member or resident will receive an automated notice
 - NOTE: If the physician did not observe the student, they can indicate that, and we will check into the discrepancy.
3. If you do not find the physician’s name who observed you, send their name and email address to Margaret Stefani Higgins at mhiggin@luc.edu and she will follow up. (*Note: email addresses are needed only for non-Loyola faculty*)
4. **Failure to complete this requirement** or enter the data into the system will result in a clerkship grade of “Incomplete” until it is completed. The deficiency may also be considered in the evaluation of your professionalism competency.
