Site/Rotation Description	<p><u>Inpatient Expectations:</u> The Psychiatric Consultation Liaison Service provides timely, efficient, and high quality psychiatric consultation services to the medical units, surgical units, intensive care units, spinal cord injury units, emergency department, observation unit and blind rehabilitation units at Edward Hines Jr. VA Hospital. The Psychiatric Consultation Liaison Service acts as the liaison between the mental health service line and the medical center. Common topics/themes of psychiatry consultation include: altered mental status, agitation, overdose (unintentional or intentional), SI/HI, substance use, mania, psychosis, capacity, medication side effects, polypharmacy, anxiety, depression.</p> <p>Students work directly with attendings on a busy inpatient consult service and are expected to participate in all aspects of patient care. This includes chart review, initial and follow up interviews with patients/family members, obtaining collateral from outside sources, communicating with primary services, care coordination, and attending family meetings and/or interdisciplinary case conferences. Students will write notes, present cases, and participate in daily rounds, including in depth discussion regarding treatment decision making and informal didactics. Students are also responsible for updating the daily CL census, which tracks new patients, patient movement within the hospital and discharges.</p> <p><u>Call:</u> please see the clerkship orientation for call requirements.
